

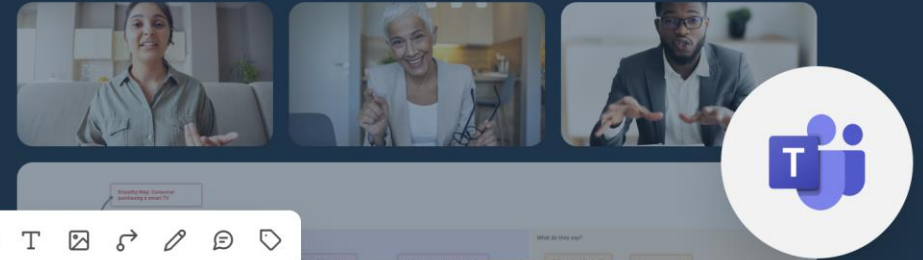

primary key: id
foreign key to users table: user_id
created_time: time that the order was placed
amount: total charge amount in USD
description: human-oriented description (# nullable)
payment_path: describes user flow leading to the order e.g., checkout page, modal prompt, invoice, etc.
is_paid: boolean indicating outstanding payment

order_items
line items within an order
primary key: id
foreign key to orders table: order_id
foreign key to products table: product_id
quantity: for bulk orders indicate number purchased
price: unit price charged in USD
created_time: time when this row was created

subscriptions
renewing credit purchased by a user
primary key: id
foreign key to order_items table: order_item_id
created_time: time when the subscription was created
canceled_time: time when the subscription was cancelled (# nullable)
expiration_time: time when the subscription is due to expire (# nullable)
is_active: boolean indicating active subscription

users
a human being on the site
primary key: id
name: full name of the user
email: email address of the user (# unique)
encrypted_password: bcrypt encrypted password
avatar_url: url to their avatar image, may be local or remote
created_time: time when this user joined the site

products
discrete things we sell
primary key: id
name: user-facing name of the product
product_category: internal category for marketing
price: USD amount for a single instance
billing_interval: renewal timing for subscription products (# nullable)
created_time: time the product was created
