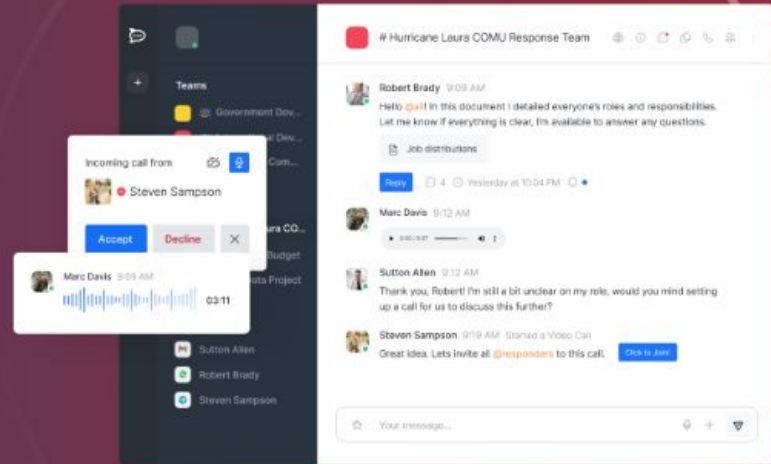

truMLS Chat

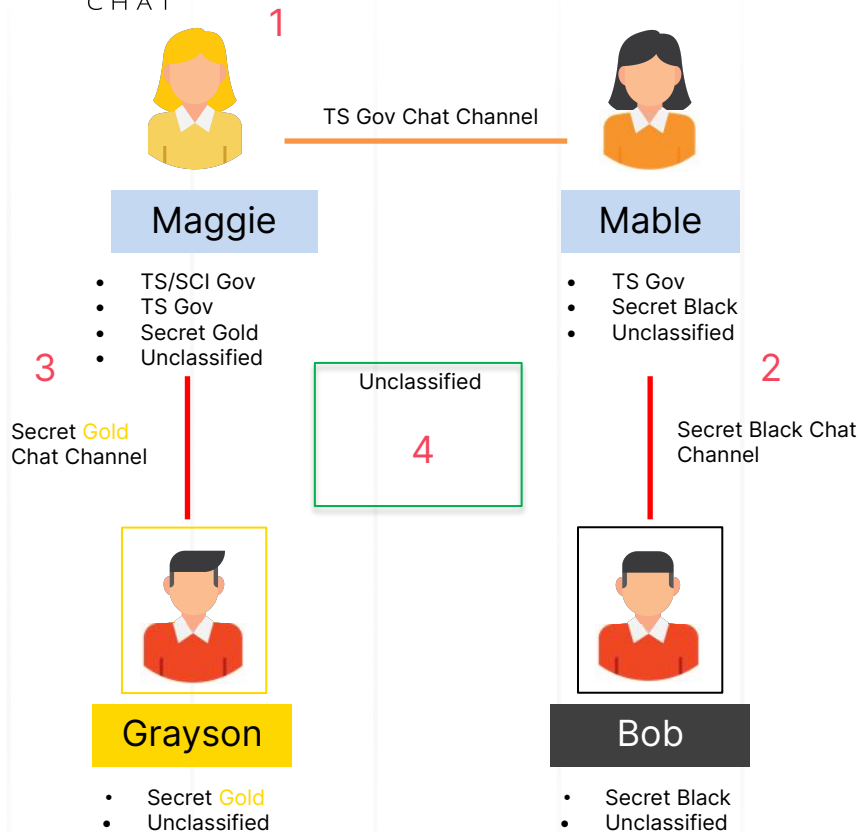

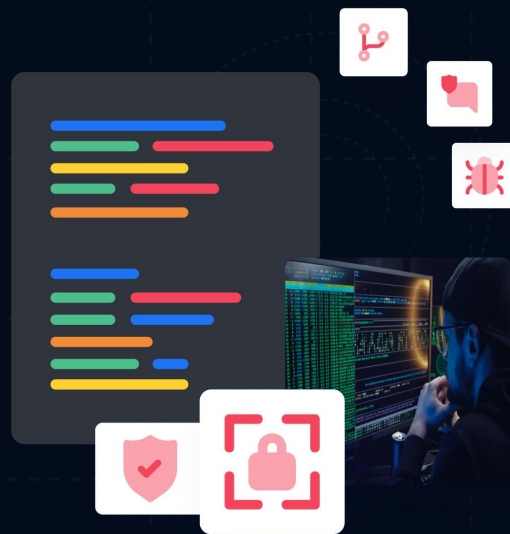
Audit panel improvements
