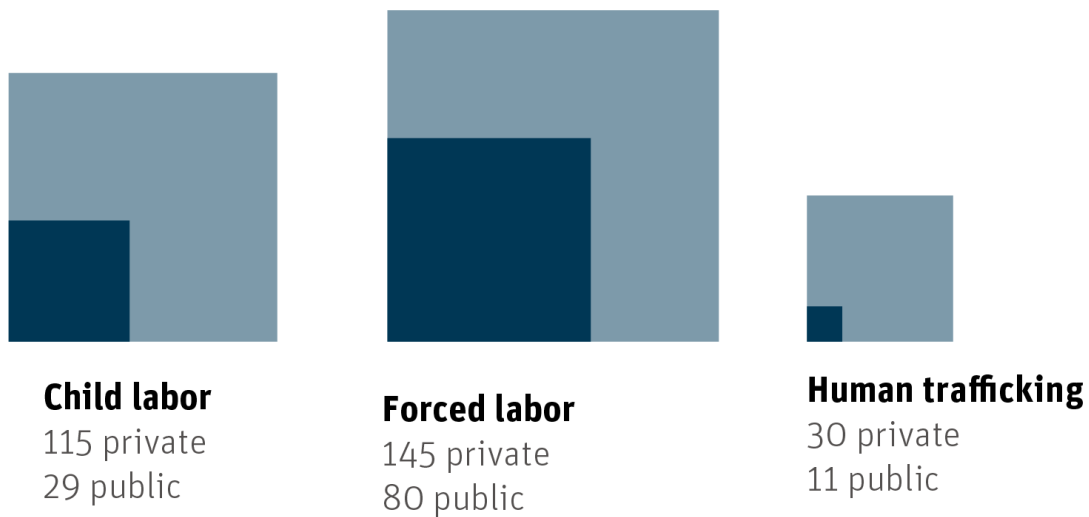

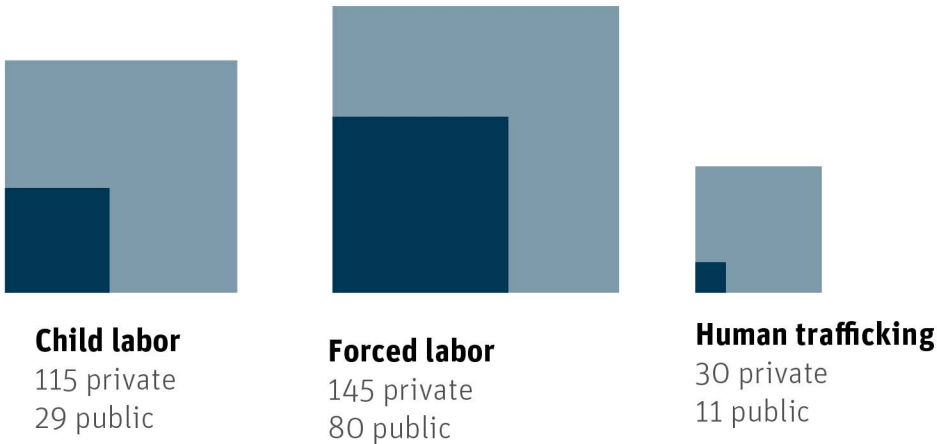


## How many US companies are exposed to modern slavery risk?
