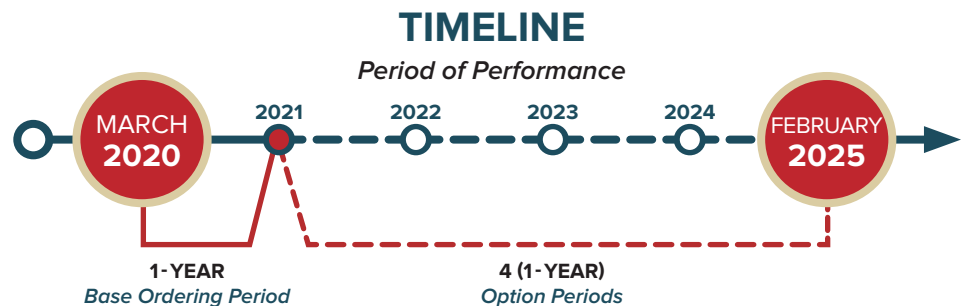

Provided Under the Agreement

ThunderCat Technology is authorized to distribute Veritas™ Technologies LLC Software, hardware and maintenance services to the DOJ and affiliated branches, including the Federal Bureau of Investigation. A wide range of Veritas' data management tools are available under this BPA, including NetBackup, NetBackup Appliances, Backup Exec, APTARE IT Analytics, eDiscovery, InfoScale & services, and cloud and digital compliance solutions.

Term of the Agreement

The agreement includes a one-year base ordering period, with four (one-year) option periods, for a total period of performance of five years. The estimated volume of purchases through this blanket purchase agreement (BPA) is \$1.81 million. Work will be performed world-wide and is expected to be completed February 28, 2021. If all options are exercised, the ordering period will extend through February 28, 2025.



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
