Statement of Work for Everfox Partner Lab Environment

Statement of Work

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A. Purpose

This Firm Fixed Price (FFP) Statement of Work (SOW) defines the scope of work to be performed by Everfox, a commercial provider of Priority Critical Cybersecurity solutions, in support of a Garrison Isolation Appliance (GIA) implementation for Everfox Partner Lab Environment.

B. Background

Everfox Partner intends to implement one (1) GIA appliance in a development lab environment to simulate user access from a classified network into one (1) higher threat network for remote browsing or virtual desktop infrastructure isolation capability. No assessment and authorization (A&A) services are required for this unclassified lab deployment support

1. Technical Summary:

- GIA will be utilized as remote browsing or to access a virtual desktop infrastructure session isolation capability to access a higher threat network environment from a trusted network for a low number of users development environment users.
- Everfox will provide onsite installation, configuration, and training services for one (1) GIA appliance at one (1) classified lab environment at one (1) CONUS location.

2. Hardware/Software Summary:

- There is one (1) Garrison Isolation Appliance (GIA) included with this effort.

C. Scope of Work

The following tasks are accounted for in the accompanying quote, based on a period of performance from the notional schedule outlined below:

1. Technical Project Management (oversight, resourcing, budgeting, scheduling, meetings, risk mitigation)

2. Conduct kickoff for the CDS implementation.

3. Pre-Onsite Engineering Services:

- System Architecture/Design and Technical Risk Mitigation
 - Develop the system architecture and identify potential technical risks
 - Propose mitigation strategies to address identified risks

→ Configuration Development

- Design the configuration for the deployment of the GIA systems

→ Create a detailed SDD containing GIA design and configuration information.

4. Onsite Implementation Services – at CONUS location:

- Onsite implementation services include one (1) Everfox engineer for up to three (3) days onsite.
- Deployment of the GIA solution

- Appliance installation and initial configuration
 - Integrate the GIA solution with network infrastructure
 - Integrate the GIA solution with existing customer provided development environment enterprise services that may include NTP, SSH, SMTP
- Install and configure supporting VM components for one (1) GIA appliance
 - Components may include: Garrison System Manager (GSM), Garrison Connection Broker (GCB), Garrison Profile Store (GPS) and Remote Certificate Database (RCD)
- Service configuration – Defining and configuring a ‘service’ in the Garrison System Manager (GSM)
- Configure third-party integrations
- Package and deploy the Garrison App

→ Configure CDS to transfer log and audit files to external log servers

→ Perform functional end-to-end testing

→ Provide CDS over-the-shoulder system administrator training

5. Post-Onsite Services:

→ Create and deliver Trip Report

→ Update and deliver final revision of the CDS SDD

G. General Assumptions

This scope of work is contingent upon the following assumptions:

1. All services will be performed as a firm fixed priced contract with recommended milestone payments described in Section E.
2. The initial period of performance (PoP) is estimated by the notional schedule. The actual schedule will be determined by the Everfox program manager and customer project manager. Execution of this SOW may depend on milestones and tasks not performed by Everfox. If additional scope or an extended period of performance is required, a modified cost estimate can be provided.
3. The customer will provide a DD254 (or equivalent) to authorize Everfox to perform any work that is classified, or in a classified space, described in this SOW.
4. Unless specifically referenced in the quote, it is assumed that any required software or hardware will be provided and made available by the customer prior to integration to include the GIA server and DTSS servers if applicable, as well as SSH/SFTP servers if applicable. This will also include hardware (either physical or virtual) to support the ingestion or distribution of data processed through the GIA.
5. It is the customer's responsibility to purchase filters required for GIA by their A&A process.
6. The customer will ensure that there is existing infrastructure in place for all networks to include Active Directory, DNS, DHCP, networking components, NTP, SSH servers, Certificate Authority Servers, and SNMP servers prior to implementation of the GIA.
7. Associated customer support personnel for System, Security, and Network engineering will be available to support integration during the travel window.
8. Licensing for any software components not furnished by Everfox will be the responsibility of the customer to procure.
9. Implementation teams will require site badges, and hands on keyboard access as allowed by site policy.
10. If identified in Section E of this SOW, travel expenses will be billed as actuals pursuant to FAR 31.205-46 Travel Costs and Everfox Travel policy with per diem rates established by either 1) Federal Travel Regulations (FTR), prescribed by the General Services Administration (GSA), for travel in the contiguous United States; 2) Defense Travel Management Office for Non-Foreign areas (e.g. Alaska, Hawaii, Guam, etc.); or 3) Standardized Regulations (Government Civilians, Foreign Areas), Section 925, "Maximum Travel Per Diem Allowances for Foreign Areas," prescribed by the Department of State, for travel in Foreign areas. In accordance with FAR 31.205-46, receipts will only be provided for expenses equal to or greater than \$75.
11. No A&A services are required for this unclassified lab deployment support.
