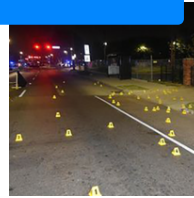

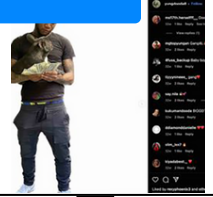
In the video, the serial number
