

Empowering employees to build and scale their own solutions

Remote work presents unique hurdles for government agencies, especially when taking into account legacy systems, organizational barriers, and security considerations.

But working remotely appears to be the future of working. According to a survey of federal workers, 80 percent think the work-from-home (WFH) pivot will continue, and 82 percent expect to work remotely three or more days a week.¹

During the pandemic, workers previously reliant on IT to develop new solutions were empowered to build their own and automate workflows from wherever they now call "the office" using no-code collaborative work management (CWM) platforms. These cloud-based platforms help create a highly collaborative environment where the majority of the projects, programs, and processes can all be managed in one place. With a CWM platform, anyone motivated to make change—who wants to push their mission forward—can do so without writing a single line of code and with the assurances of built-in security and IT oversight.

According to Gartner, 41 percent of non-IT employees customize or build technology solutions today.² Gartner also predicts that by 2024, 80 percent of technology products will be built by non-tech professionals.³ With the line between technical and nontechnical roles blurring, this trend is catching on in the federal government. Accenture found that a whopping 91 percent of federal executives reported that their organizations are innovating with an urgency and call to action in 2021.⁴ That comes as 71 percent of technology decision-makers are rethinking longer-term strategic decisions around workforce technology.⁵

The no-code CWM platform and the democratization of technology

Teams across the federal government are breaking down silos and establishing real-time visibility across initiatives to increase mission effectiveness. By turning to a new breed of no-code solutions like CWM, agencies can minimize shadow IT while empowering teams to meet their missions more effectively using an agency-approved tool, all with the aid and support of their IT departments.

Now with fewer technical barriers, virtually any employee can build no-code applications without needing to know how to write code. The 2020 No-Code Census report discovered it is "4.6x faster and more affordable to build with no-code tools when compared to traditional programming tools." With this in mind, if federal employees were empowered to create innovative new systems and applications without having to learn a large number of new skills, it could create a breakthrough innovation cycle.

This no-code democratization of technology creates exciting opportunities as workers build and scale their own processes to better connect the work being done across their organizations. Among federal executives, 89 percent believe technology democratization is becoming critical to ignite innovation. Similarly, Accenture said in its recent virtual workplace study:



Give teams the power to unlock innovation

With Smartsheet Gov, agencies can bring together mission-critical data sources into a secure, compliant CWM platform. This affords greater visibility into how the organization is running, enables true collaboration and transparency, and helps agencies quickly pivot, making data-driven decisions at speed.

"Personally, as a leader, I like to access data about how my priorities are working, or my goals are being achieved, whenever I want," says Marina Nitze, former CTO of the United States Department of Veterans Affairs. "A tool like Smartsheet that aggregates data from different systems helps me see in real time how I'm doing and if I need to intervene."

Recently, one division of the U.S. Department of Defense was able to dramatically improve communications between air support and ground troops by tracking assets through one centralized source with real-time data.

In another example, a large, civilian agency simplified reporting on management across its grants, cooperative agreements, and contracts, saving each person involved eight working hours per week.

Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory used Smartsheet as a single source of truth for process management and approvals, tracking who goes where, when, and how.

"In our divisions, everything is now logged in Smartsheet—the discussions, the approval status, the costs associated; with one place to track this information, instead of 50 different Excel files, we are confident it's up to date," says Tom Gallant, Senior Administrative Supervisor, Physical Sciences Divisions, Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory.


