Individuals looking for treatment can use tools and resources to help them evaluate the type of care they need, easily search for appropriate, nearby providers, and submit confidential referral requests to a network of trusted treatment providers.

Features:

- Educational resources to help learn about and search for suitable treatment
- The Addiction Treatment Needs Assessment tool to help guide individuals on the best treatment options for their needs
- Ability to search by zip code, distance, substance, and treatment type
- Ability to anonymously reach out to treatment providers via the online portal
- State-specific helpline and resource information on search results page
- View of treatment facility availability

- Central resource for learning about and finding substance use and mental health treatment
- Connecting with trusted treatment providers via a state sponsored network
- Empowers individuals to make informed treatment decisions

The **Addiction Treatment Needs Assessment (ATNA)** is a validated decision support tool built with the American Society on Addiction Medicine (ASAM) based on their gold standard patient placement criteria. ATNA has been built to rapidly assess an individual's severity/risk in just thirteen questions that can be completed by the patient or a loved one. Assessment results help individuals narrow down treatment options that are most likely to meet their needs and put them on the best path towards recovery.
