

NORTH CAROLINA'S MILITARY AND RESEARCH INDUSTRY

With major military installations like Fort Bragg and Camp Lejeune, along with The Triangle's high-tech industry, North Carolina has a robust cleared workforce.

North Carolina cleared salaries hover around \$102,876—lower than the national average, but balanced by a reasonable cost of living. With research centers and military installations throughout the state, job options remain strong, and the quality of life continues to attract top talent.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT OUR REPORT

Compensation data is based on the 2024 Security Clearance Compensation Survey that was administered online by ClearanceJobs. The report also compares to prior compensation surveys administered by ClearanceJobs.

By definition, all respondents included in this analysis have an active or current security clearance issued by the U.S. federal government, are not active-duty military, are employed, and reported compensation figures between \$18,000 and \$350,000.
